

SEX OFFENDER INFORMATION FACT SHEET
RISK LEVEL 3 NOTIFICATION
Minneapolis Police Department

The Minneapolis Police Department is releasing the following information pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 244.052, which authorizes law enforcement agencies to inform the public of a sex offender who has been released from custody regarding his criminal conviction. This disclosure is to inform you that the individual who appears on this notification has been convicted of a sex offense or other offense that requires registration with the local law enforcement agency that has jurisdiction over their residence. This offender has advised the Minneapolis Police Department that he is living in our community and is residing in the area of the **5400 Block Of 29th Avenue South, The Wenonah Neighborhood.**

THIS OFFENDER IS NOT WANTED BY THE POLICE AT THIS TIME.

This notification is not intended to increase fear. It is our belief that an informed public is a safer public. The Minneapolis Police Department has no legal authority to direct where a released offender may or may not live. Unless court ordered restrictions exist, an offender may live wherever he chooses.

Sex offenders have always lived in our communities but it was not until passage of the **Community Notification Bill** and **Sex Offender Registration Act**, that law enforcement knew where they were living. Due to the passage of these laws, law enforcement can now share information with the public. Abuse of this information to threaten, intimidate, or harass registered sex offenders will not be tolerated and may be a crime. Such abuse could potentially end our ability to notify the community when sex offenders are released into the public.

The Minneapolis Police Department is available to help you by providing you with useful information on personal safety. They will also provide tips to instruct your children on personal safety.

THE RELEASED OFFENDER: Charles Henry Brown Dob 07/30/79

DESCRIPTION OF OFFENDER: White Male, 5'10", 161 Lbs, Slender Build, Blue Eyes, Medium Complexion, Short Brown Hair , And Clean Shaven.

DESCRIPTION OF OFFENSE: This offender's victim pool are minor aged females 14 to 15 years old. The sexual contact involved sexual penetration offenses. In each of the two prior cases, the victim and suspect were acquainted. In the first instance, in 1995, the case was intrafamilial in nature, in that the victim was an adopted sister. Neither case involved additional threats, force, or assaultive behaviors. This offender was revoked in 2000, 2001, and 2002 for failure to abide by his" Conditions of Release. "

CONDITIONS OF RELEASE:

- May not have direct/indirect contact with minors ,or previous victims.
- Must refrain from possessing, or consuming alcoholic beverages and illicit drugs.
- Must complete sex offender treatment programming.
- May not possess or obtain pornography in any venue.
- Must submit to drug/alcohol testing by agent when ordered to do so.
- Must submit to polygraph examination upon agent request.
 - Mr. Brown will remain supervised until 10/04/2020.
 - Governing Offense: Criminal Sexual Conduct 3rd Degree.
