

SEX OFFENDER INFORMATION FACT SHEET
RISK LEVEL 3 NOTIFICATION
Minneapolis Police Department

The Minneapolis Police Department is releasing the following information pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 244.052, which authorizes law enforcement agencies to inform the public of a sex offender who has been released from custody regarding his criminal conviction. This disclosure is to inform you that the individual who appears on this notification has been convicted of a sex offense or other offense that requires registration with the local law enforcement agency that has jurisdiction over their residence. This offender has advised the Minneapolis Police Department that he is living in our community and is residing in the area of the **5700 Block Of 34th Avenue South, The Wenonah Neighborhood.**

This notification is not intended to increase fear. It is our belief that an informed public is a safer public. The Minneapolis Police Department has no legal authority to direct where a released offender may or may not live. Unless court ordered restrictions exist, an offender may live wherever he chooses.

Sex offenders have always lived in our communities but it was not until passage of the **Community Notification Bill** and **Sex Offender Registration Act**, that law enforcement knew where they were living. Due to the passage of these laws, law enforcement can now share information with the public. Abuse of this information to threaten, intimidate, or harass registered sex offenders will not be tolerated and may be a crime. Such abuse could potentially end our ability to notify the community when sex offenders are released into the public.

The Minneapolis Police Department is available to help you by providing you with useful information on personal safety. They will also provide tips to instruct your children on personal safety.

THE RELEASED OFFENDER: Bruce Edward Patterson Dob 02/19/62

DESCRIPTION OF OFFENDER: African American Male, 5'9", 190 Lbs, Medium Build, Medium Brown Complexion, Brown Eyes, Short Black Natural Hair, With A mustache And Stubble Goatee. Wears Glasses.

DESCRIPTION OF OFFENSE: This offender's potential victim pool includes males and females aged 9 to 12, as well as adult females. This offender attempted the sexual assault of an adult female, but failed. Sexual contact with the minor children was confined to fondling activity. Access to the minor children was gained at a park where sexually suggestive language was used prior to groping behavior. Mr. Patterson was revoked on 01/12/07 for failure to complete residential treatment programming. : Lifetime Registrant
